The sole purpose of CSA Utah is to connect CSA farmers and customers.

In 2011, the Natural Resource Conservation Service pulled funding and staff from all RC&Ds in the United States. As a result, the GSL RC&D lost its full-time staff member and annual funding allocation. This significantly affected the council's ability to promote and support CSA Utah and its farmers.

The GSL RC&D is now an all volunteer board. Despite budget constraints, we've continued promoting our farmers by hosting the annual CSA Open House, and CSA Farm Tour and Dinner.

Funds raised from CSA Utah Association fees will be used to promote CSA Utah and its farmers through increased advertising and outreach efforts. The more we raise, the more we will be able to accomplish.

The flexible fee structure does not require any farm to pay. We are all inclusive and want all Utah's CSA farms to join. However, member benefits do increase based upon what tier the farm signs up for.

This is a different model than in the past. Having more resources available to us will ensure that we increase CSA Utah visibility in 2016.
